	In general, seam sealer labor and materials are considered included, and specifically seam sealer labor is always included.
	Materials can be considered on a case by case bases when an excessive amount is needed, such as a Quarter panel with a rear body panel replace. That's a whole lot of seam sealer. Just a standard rear body panel replaceumm probably not.
	Another exception is on some older cars that have that honkin huge wide bead of seam sealer from the factory. I haven't seen one of those in a while.
	Never on panel repairs, only on panel replace. And it needs to be a whole lot before it's considered.
