Clearcoat Guarantee/Warranty Issues

Consumers demand a high level of quality in their vehicles appearance. All OEM car companies offer extensive paint warranties. Almost all automobiles, vans, and light trucks are finished with an OEM basecoat/clearcoat paint system. The OEM clearcoat provides protection for the vehicles painted exterior panels against UV rays, rock chips, and the environment in general.

Some car companies have strong "recommendations" about this situation when the repair is "customer pay" as well!

Some car companies have specific procedures for warranty repairs when refinishing an OEM clearcoat where no definite break line exists for "stopping" the clear.

Essentially, the OEM warranty procedures or recommendations mentioned above are similar to the statement below:

"When performing warranty repairs on an OEM basecoat/clearcoat finish, if no clean break or body line exists for stopping the application of clearcoat, extend the application of clear to the nearest panel edge or break point".

 The following statements are very important, please read them carefully:

If a collision center provides paint warranty repair services to any OEM dealership they MUST be aware of all appropriate paint related OEM technical bulletins and warranty policies.

This information can ensure the collision center is following proper warranty procedures!
