**Methodology:**

We surveyed 2,000 U.S. drivers who own a car and have car insurance on OnePoll to see if Americans think they are overpaying for car insurance, to find out how frequently drivers compare quotes from other insurers, and to uncover why drivers change car insurance companies. Data was collected from May 20 - 21 2022. The margin of error is +/- 2.2 points with 95% confidence.
