Similarly, the Office of the Attorney General stipulates that it does not intend to, and will not, exercise its enforcement authority under Chapter 93A, Chapter 93K, or otherwise, to enforce any provision of the Data Access Law until after the Court rules on counts 1 and 2 of the plaintiff's complaint. The Office of the Attorney General reserves the right to revise this stipulation in the event that adjudication of those claims is delayed beyond July 1, 2022, but further stipulates that it will do so only after first providing 14 days' advance notice to the plaintiff and the Court of its intent to do so.
